Update: Depleted Uranium (Prohibition) Bill blocked

28 June 2012

The first reading of the Depleted Uranium (Prohibition) Bill took place last night, and its passage was blocked by National and Act MPs so unfortunately there will be no opportunity for the Bill to be considered by Select Committee.

Labour, the Green Party, New Zealand First, the Maori Party, United Future and Mana voted in support of the Bill, but as only two of the three Maori Party votes was used, the vote was 60 for and 60 against - one vote short of the majority required.
